## MIT Technology Review is looking for the 35 brightest young innovators in Europe

- The technology magazine from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology launches a regional program in Europe to recognize the talent of young people with the most disruptive technological projects.
- [Innovators Under 35 Europe 2017](#) is looking for the 35 entrepreneurs with the best innovative projects within the European Union.
- [Nominations will be open](#) until 5 March for candidates born in Europe or who have resided for at least five years in one of the European Union countries.

**Madrid, January 23, 2017.**- [MIT Technology Review](#), the world's oldest technology magazine, owned by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), presents the new edition of Innovators Under 35 Europe aimed at finding the brightest minds of Europe.

This publication begins the search for the 35 best Innovators Under 35 from all countries in the European Union, in order to discover, present and recognize the most advanced technological projects in the region and continue to consolidate its European community of innovators, pioneers and agents of change.

**Nominations will be open until 5 March 2017** for all candidates born in the European Union or with more than five years of residence in one of its member states. Participants must be under 35 and their technological projects should be framed within areas such as biotechnology, hardware, telecommunications, transportation, energy, among others; and also have the potential to impact the world and transform the way we live today.

Following the closing of nominations, a jury composed by experts and editors of MIT Technology Review will select the best 35 proposals. The winners will be presented at the awards ceremony that will take place in Paris next September with the support of [BNP Paribas](#) and [L'Atelier BNP Paribas](#). This **ceremony** will gather the community of Innovators Under 35 in France on **September 14th** to welcome the new generation of leaders and innovators of the future.

In addition, as part of the events organized by MIT Technology Review in Europe this year, the winners of the Innovators Under 35 award will have the opportunity to participate in [EmTech France](#) a conference that will be held in Toulouse, October 10 and 11. EmTech is the annual event organized around the world by this publication (United States, Asia, Europe, Latin America) that brings together the most important researchers and entrepreneurs in emerging technologies to present their latest advances.



All Innovators Under 35 selected this year will become part of this community, made up of more than 250 European innovators that have been previously awarded among the more than 4,000 candidates who have submitted their application to the competition since its creation. Some of these winners are:
